No Brasil, a Área de Gerontologia vem ganhando espaço na sociedade como no meio acadêmico. A música tem um papel fundamental no envelhecimento saudável, atuando como um poderoso estímulo cognitivo, emocional e social. Diversas pesquisas demonstram que atividades musicais contribuem para a melhora do humor, da memória e da coordenação motora, além de fortalecerem os vínculos sociais e promoverem o bem-estar entre os idosos. No contexto da Gerontologia, a música se revela uma ferramenta terapêutica acessível e eficaz, capaz de proporcionar qualidade de vida e ampliar a autonomia na longevidade. O Método YURA-Ritmo surge justamente com esse propósito: integrar corpo, mente e emoção por meio da música, promovendo experiências significativas e transformadoras na vida das pessoas idosas. O YURA-Ritmo Co. é a empresa japonesa que desenvolveu uma metodologia exclusiva no Japão (Sendai-Miyagi). Foi trazida por eles ao Brasil com o apoio da JICA (Japan International Cooperation Agency), Governo da Província de Miyagi (Japão) em parceria com a EACH-USP (Escola de Artes, Ciências e Humanidades da Universidade de São Paulo). Teve como objetivo a promoção de saúde no envelhecimento por meio da música (consiste no uso de três técnicas: Yura atividade física, Yura música com instrumentos e Yura relaxamento). O projeto foi desenvolvido de 2021-2023, sendo concluído com êxito, envolvendo mais de 3.000 pessoas idosas. Foram capacitados 32 instrutores entre Professores, profissionais de saúde e da área social. Após seu término vários grupos e seus instrutores continuam com a aplicação do método YURA, sendo importante realizarmos um encontro reunindo os profissionais que foram capacitados pelo projeto YURA, além dos que receberam a formação no curso Nikkey de estágio no YURA-Ritmo. Convidaremos também os grupos de pessoas idosas que frequentam as oficinas YURA além de acadêmicos da Gerontologia. Projeto “Descobrimdo o Japão” completa cinco anos de atuação em escolas públicas de SP

São Paulo – O Projeto Descobrimdo o Japão chega ao seu quinto ano em 2025, consolidando-se como uma iniciativa de difusão cultural que tem aproximado crianças e jovens da rede pública de ensino da cultura japonesa. Criado em 2021, em meio à pandemia, o projeto nasceu da perseverança e da organização de sua idealizadora, Emi Imai, e desde então já promoveu quase 200 workshops, beneficiando diretamente 560 estudantes.

A primeira edição ocorreu de forma virtual, com 14 oficinas on-line, abordando diferentes aspectos da tradição e do cotidiano do Japão. O conteúdo vai desde atividades práticas, como arte de embalagem (sacolas de papel), origami, arte de pipa, oshibana-e (arte com flores secas), Hiragana (escrita japonesa), Kawaii Obentô (marmitta decoradas), até práticas culturais como o Iki-gai (arte de viver feliz), a dança do leão lendário (Shishimai), danças Kabuki, o jogo milenar Go, o Shogun, além de ensinamentos como Feng Shui, Mottainai (sustentabilidade), a filosofia do Houtoku, inspirada em Kinjiro Ninomiya e a filosofia e a prática do kendô (arte marcial).

O programa também inclui oficinas de mangá, música tradicional japonesa, arte do chá e

palestras sobre segurança, liderança, técnicas de oratória, histórias das províncias japonesas e até oportunidades de estudo no Japão. Outra vertente importante são as atividades externas, como visitas à Japan House, ao Museu da Imigração Japonesa e passeios culturais pelo bairro da Liberdade.

Desde então, a iniciativa alcançou diversas unidades, entre elas: EE Lasar Segall, EE Brasílio Machado, EE Princesa Isabel, EE Gomes Cardim Professor e EE Marechal Deodoro.

No Ensino Fundamental II, o projeto é oferecido dentro da disciplina eletiva, escolhida pelos alunos. Já no Fundamental I, as atividades ocorrem após o almoço, permitindo a participação voluntária dos estudantes interessados.

No primeiro semestre de 2025, o projeto esteve presente nas escolas EE Major Arcy e EE Princesa Isabel, com a realização de aproximadamente 35 workshops. Já no segundo semestre, mantém as atividades na

Environmental Education Workshop with SEMIL Park Monitors – February 3, 2026

Event Description: The workshop was designed as an intensive training program aimed at enhancing the pedagogical approaches of monitors working in state and urban parks in São Paulo. The primary objective was the transition from “contemplative monitoring” to “active and scientific monitoring,” incorporating Japanese methodologies of nature interpretation (such as *Shinrin-yoku*) and citizen science tools to engage visitors in biodiversity conservation.
